Oath Concerning Requirements to Receive the Emergency Student Support Handout

To apply for the Emergency Student Support Handout provided by the Japan Student Services Organization, I have confirmed that I meet application criteria (1) through (6) below (or (1) through (5) and (7) if an international student).

(4) Due to a loss of income for your family (parents) or other such reason, you do not expect to receive additional support from family.		
(5) You have lost a significant amount (50% or more compared to the previous month) of part-time income due to the coronavirus (including compensation for absence from work through the employment adjustment subsidy).		
(6) You qualify for one or more of the following programs.		
1) You are a Class I recipient under the New Higher Education Support System ("New System" below).		
2) You are a Class II or III recipient under the New System AND a student eligible to simultaneously receive a Category I scholarship who has used or plans to use the entire scholarship.		
3) You are an applicant to the New System or plan to use the New System AND you have used or plan to use your entire Category I scholarship.		
4) You are not eligible for the New System AND you have used or plan to use your entire Category I scholarship.		
5) You cannot use the New System or a Category I scholarship because you do not meet the criteria, BUT you plan to use a support system provided by the private sector or elsewhere for which you are eligible to apply.		
(7) An international student or the like (including students at Japanese language schools) must fulfill the following criteria IN ADDITION TO experiencing economic hardship accompanying the novel coronavirus pandemic. 1) You are a student with excellent grades. Specifically, your average grades for the previous school must be 2.30 or higher. 2) Your monthly attendance is at least 80%. 3) You receive an average of no more than 90,000 yen in monthly remittances (not including funds for paying admission fees, test fees, etc.). 4) Your supporter in Japan has an annual income of less than 5 million yen.		

Be sure to enter **the annual amount** (including rent but excluding tuition fees), not the monthly amount.
Please submit copies of the relevant pages of your bank book as evidence to confirm the amount received from your family.
Note: enter the same amount as you entered in the "Form for Confirmation of Household Income Status."

Submit a copy of your apartment lease or a copy of your certificate of residence as evidence to confirm that you are living separately from your family.

Be sure to enter **the annual amount**, not the monthly amount.
Note: enter the same amount as you entered in the "Form for Confirmation of Household Income Status."

If you are receiving any other public assistance provided as a relief measure for hardship caused by the novel coronavirus, please submit the certificate of receipt. If you cannot presently submit the certificate for reasons such as the procedures still being in process, please explain the reason in Column 3 "Items to Submit" of Form 1.

If you are not receiving any public assistance, but your household income has decreased significantly, please provide details of your household income situation in Column 3 "Items to Submit" of Form 1.

For "The current month," please enter a month in 2020 in which your income from part-time work significantly decreased.
Example:
Income in March (Previous Month): 80,000 yen
Income in April (Current Month): 35,000 yen

● Categories I, II, and III are classified based on the income levels defined in the New Higher Education Support System, which has been implemented for undergraduate students since April 2020. Items 1), 2), and 3) are not applicable to graduate students.
