**Putonghua Courses**

**Level 1 (Lower)**

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH1113 Application of Vocabulary and Grammar I (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An elementary course designed to familiarize students with the use of basic vocabulary and grammar points. Vocabulary introduced based on everyday conversations and daily usage. Focus will be on appropriateness in application.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Basic Chinese A Short Course I – Application of Vocabulary and Grammar I edited by the Chinese Language Centre.

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH1123 Oral Skills Practice I (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An elementary course focused on students' fluency in communication with basic vocabulary and grammar points through various kinds of speaking practice. Real life settings are introduced such as shopping, introducing family members, asking directions etc.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Basic Chinese A Short Course I – Oral Skills Practice I, edited by the Chinese Language Centre.

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**Putonghua Courses**

**Level 1 (Upper)**

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH1133 Communication in Context I (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An elementary course designed to familiarize students with basic vocabulary and grammar points through language tasks/activities and contextualized exercises. Real life settings are introduced such as shopping, introducing family members, asking directions etc.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Basic Chinese A Short Course II- part 1, edited by the Chinese Language Centre.

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH1153 Basic Presentation Skills &amp; Daily Situations I (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An elementary course helps students to build up abilities in presenting basic ideas in real life communication settings. Tasks like picture description, speaking topics and simple presentation will be adopted to train students in presentation with various everyday settings.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Basic Chinese A Short Course II – Part 2, edited by the Chinese Language Centre.

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**Level 2**

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH2233 Communication in Context II (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An intermediate course designed to familiarize students with newly acquired vocabulary and grammar points through language tasks/ activities and contextualized exercises in real life settings.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Kung Fu II – part 2, edited by the Chinese Language Centre.

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH2253 Basic Presentation Skills &amp; Daily Situations II (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An intermediate course to help students improve their proficiency to communicate in authentic situations by integrating the newly acquired vocabulary items and grammar structures.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Kung Fu II – Part 2, edited by the Chinese Language Centre.

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**Putonghua Courses**

**Level 3**

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH3313 Application of Vocabulary and Grammar III (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An upper intermediate course to familiarize students with the use of newly acquired vocabulary and grammar points. Focus will be on the appropriateness in application. Topics include various aspects on Chinese language and culture.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Chinese Language and Culture – An Intermediate Reader by Weijia Huang and Qun Ao, CUHK Press.

<b>Course</b>	<b>CPTH3323 Oral Skills Practice III (3 credits)</b>
<b>Course Description</b>	An upper intermediate course focused on students' fluency in speaking practice with newly acquired vocabulary and grammar points. Topics include various aspects on Chinese language and culture.
<b>Course Requirements</b>	This is an intensive course covers a total of 38 teaching hours. The final grade is based on students' preparation and participation (20%), homework assignments (10%), quizzes on listening and reading comprehension (40%) and 1 written exam. (30%).
<b>Course Material</b>	Textbook: Chinese Language and Culture – An Intermediate Reader by Weijia Huang and Qun Ao, CUHK Press.
