  - Teaching of undergraduate courses on informatics in English at Institute for Liberal Arts and Sciences (4 classes per year; One class consists of weekly 90-minute lectures for 15 weeks). The courses include: Fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence, Practice of Basic Informatics, and Information Literacy for Academic Study (subject to change)
  - Teaching at Graduate School of Informatics (the international course)
  - Research and research guidance for graduate students at Department of Intelligence Science and Technology

3. Ability to teach courses in English on informatics at the undergraduate and graduate levels

5. Willingness to act according to the Mission Statement of Kyoto University
6. Native-level proficiency in English
7. Understanding of Japanese culture

Working hours: 38 hours 45 minutes per week under the flexible-hours system.
