The Center for Medical Education and Internationalization at the Graduate School of Medicine, Kyoto University invites applications for a tenured professor position. We also accept recommendations for appropriate candidates.

1. Job title, Number of positions:

One (1) Tenured Professor

2. Location:

The Center for Medical Education and Internationalization at the Graduate School of Medicine, Kyoto University (Yoshida-Konoe-cho, Sakyo-ku, Kyoto 606-8501, JAPAN)

3. Job description:

The major aims of the Center for Medical Education and Internationalization at the Graduate School of Medicine, Kyoto University, are to implement the most advanced medical education, advance the internationalization of the school, and promote global collaboration with other universities and research institutions. In this call, we seek an established scholar for the position of tenured professor at the International Education Section of the Center. The successful candidate will be engaged in developing innovative medical education programs (in English) and building new collaborative networks while strengthening existing ones to promote the internationalization of the school, in collaboration with the Director of the Center, the Chief of the Section, and other members in the Center. The candidate must be able to give lectures in English to the undergraduate students in the programs offered by the Institute for Liberal Arts and Sciences: "Introduction to Biochemistry", "Introduction to Molecular Biotechnology", and "Principles of Genetics". The successful candidate is also expected to have an outstanding track record in research and to continue his/her research projects at the school.

4. Eligibility:

The requirement for the candidate is:

1. To have a Ph.D. and/or M.D.
2. Non-Japanese nationality
3. Fluent in communications in English. The ability to communicate in Japanese is not necessary.
4. To have the ability to give lectures in these three courses (2 classes per week x 30 weeks) to undergraduate students in English: "Introduction to Biochemistry", "Introduction to Molecular Biotechnology", and "Principles of Genetics."

5. Starting date:

The earliest possible date after the election (negotiable)

6. Probation period:

6 months

7. Business hours:

Discretionary labor system, based on 7 hours, 45 minutes (8:30–17:15 work schedule with a one-hour break) per day, 38 hours 45 minutes per week.

Days off: Saturdays, Sundays, National holidays, Year-end and New Year holidays, Foundation Day

8. Salary and allowances:

To be determined in accordance with Kyoto University regulations

1. CV

(1) Include full name, gender, date of birth, age, current address, postal code, current position, and contact information.

(2) Educational background, licenses, degrees

(3) Employment history

(4) Awards and penalties

(5) Others (professional societies and other social activities)

The above items (1) through (5) should be listed with the date. Use A4 papers.

2. Publication List

(1) Original manuscripts (in chronological order) and Reviews (in chronological order). Circle 10 representative publications for which PDF files are submitted.

(2) Include the name of the author(s) (underline the name of the author(s) in the order in which they appear in the paper), title, journal name, volume and page, and year of publication.

(3) Use A4 papers.

3. Status of Research Grant, etc.

List the types of national/public research funds and other private grants received, the name of the subject, and the representative/assistant researcher(s), in order of the year.

4. Research statement

2 pages of A4 size.

5. Educational statements

2 pages of A4 size.
