Position Overview

The successful candidate will engage in research on magnetically confined fusion plasma toward the realization of fusion energy under the Cabinet Office's Moonshot Goal 10 program. The appointee will be responsible for one or more of the following research topics, depending on their expertise and the progress of the project:

1. Plasma profile prediction via the coupling of multi-fidelity turbulence transport model and transport code
2. Research on nonlocal turbulent transport modeling

Specific research duties will be determined in consultation with the successful candidate.

 - Research experience in one or more of the following fields is preferred:
 - Fusion science
 - Computational and mathematical sciences
