Job description	In 2009, Kyoto University inaugurated the Hakubi Project to Foster and Support Young Researchers, in which the University appoints promising young researchers to support their research activities as world-leading researchers and to develop visionary researchers who will pioneer new paths in their respective academic fields. Research projects in all fields of the humanities, social sciences and natural sciences are welcome.
Required qualifications	Researchers with a doctoral degree (or equivalent research abilities) are eligible. All nationalities are accepted. Those who have previously been appointed to the Hakubi Project to Foster and Support Young Researchers are not eligible. It is not possible to apply for both the Global type and Tenure-track Type appointments at the same academic year in Japan.
Contract term	The term of office will be 5 years in principle. There can be no renewal of the appointment.
Business hours	Seven hours and 45 minutes per day, 38 hours 45 minutes per week under a discretionary work system. Holidays: Weekends, National holidays, Year-end and New Year holidays, the University Foundation Day (June 18th), and summer vacation.
Salary	To be determined in accordance with the existing employment regulations of Kyoto University.

Social insurance	Appointees will be eligible for MEXT mutual aid association membership, employees' pension, employment insurance, and workers' compensation insurance.

Screening Method	<p>(Primary screening)</p> <p>An expert committee at the Hakubi Center for Advanced Research, Kyoto University from the applicant’s respective academic fields will examine application documents, focusing on academic achievements and research plans.</p> <p>(Secondary screening)</p> <p>The Hakuraku Council under the Hakubi Center for Advanced Research, Kyoto University will conduct interviews. In addition to applicants’ academic achievements, the Council will evaluate their potential to become leading figures in the future global academic community. Interviews will be held at Yoshida Campus, Kyoto University.</p> <p>(Third screening)</p> <p>The Steering Committee of the Hakubi Center for Advanced Research, Kyoto University will make the final decision as to who is accepted as a Hakubi researcher, considering the results of interviews held by the Hakuraku Council, etc.</p>
