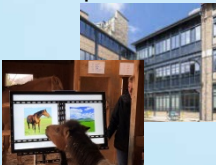

Functions: Advanced research in the field of chemistry, expansion of international joint usage/research, and collaboration with industrial partners

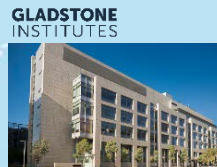
Center for Advanced Genomic Field Science
