for Sick Children and Request for Your Understanding and Cooperation in Conducting a

Prior Medical Examination

Kyoto University Gender Equality Promotion Center Nursery Room for Sick Children ("Kyoto

University Nursery Room for Sick Children") is a day care facility to provide care for sick or

convalescent children of female Kyoto University faculty, staff and students, so that they do not

have to take leave from work to care for their children who cannot attend their regular day care

facility, kindergarten or elementary school.

Kyoto University Nursery Room for Sick Children provides nursery care for sick children,

regardless of whether they are ill or convalescent, but will not admit children with an infectious

disease or if they are in a critical condition. Accordingly, we ask parents to have their child examined

by a physician in advance, to check whether the child is suffering from an infectious disease or

serious illness. A prior medical examination is also important to ensure that the child care workers

understand the health status of the child and can accordingly give appropriate care.

Kyoto University Nursery Room for Sick Children requires a physician's report to be submitted

on the day of visit to the Room and it must include the results of the prior medical examination

of the child. You are kindly requested to fill in the Physician's Report form (another sheet) that

will be brought to you by the child's parent or guardian.

I sincerely request that you understand the purpose of Kyoto University Nursery Room for Sick

Children and the importance of conducting the prior medical examination, as stated above, and

that you take time to complete the Physician's Report.
