1897 Founded as Kyoto Imperial University.

- 1953 Graduate courses under the new system opened. Yukawa Institute for Theoretical Physics established.
- 1954 Branch School renamed College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
- 1956 Institute for Virus Research established.
- 1960 Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences established.
- 1962 Institute of Economic Research established.
- 1963 Research Institute for Mathematical Sciences and Research Reactor Institute established.
- 1965 Center for Southeast Asian Studies established.
- 1966 Center for Student Health established.


