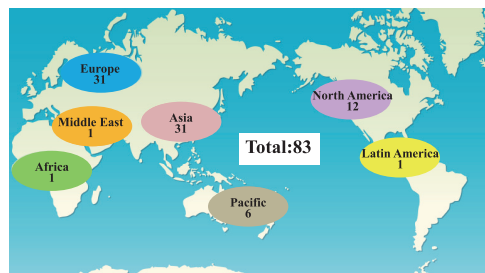


Partner Universities and Consortia

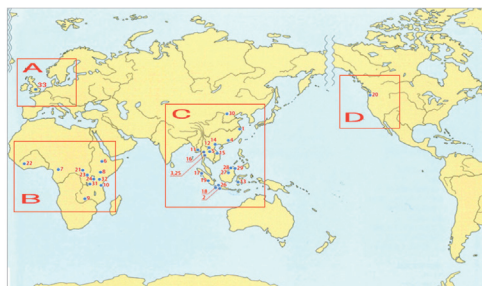
