



- @st.kyoto-u.ac.jp (KUMOI)

Please be aware that this is not the same as the following kinds of emails.

- @\*\*\*\*(other than st).kyoto-u.ac.jp (address issued independently by a department)
- @kyoto-u.jp (lifetime address for transfer)
