### **Application for Special Provisions during the Second Semester of 2021**

In principle, classes at Kyoto University will be provided as face-to-face classes during the second semester of 2021. The classes will be provided while taking all possible measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. However, students who are at a higher risk of developing serious symptoms due to preexisting conditions, etc., are requested to apply for special provisions using the attached form (Application for Special Provisions during the Second Semester of 2021). The form should be submitted to the section in charge of education affairs of your department of affiliation. Depending on the results of a review of their application, such students may be provided with online classes.

If you wish to apply for such special provisions, please see the detailed information below, and submit the application together with all other necessary documents during the specified application period.

#### **Application period:**

For currently enrolled students: August 2 (Mon.)–August 23 (Mon.), 2021

For newly enrolled students: August 23 (Mon.)–September 17 (Fri.), 2021

#### **Important points to note regarding online classes**

- The specific provision will vary depending on the course (for example, classes may be provided as audio recordings [recorded using a voice recorder, etc.], or class materials may be provided via PandA or other online tools).
- Depending on the course, credits may not be awarded to students who only take the classes online.
- Depending on the course, students who do not attend classes in person at the university may not receive a performance evaluation.
