Depending on the results of a review of their application, such students may be provided with online classes.

application together with all other necessary documents during the specified application period.

For currently enrolled students: February 12 (Fri.)-February 22 (Mon.), 2021

Important points to note regarding online classes

In AY 2020, online classes were provided for all students. However, during the first semester of AY 2021,

online classes will only be provided for individual students who qualify for the special provisions (classes will

be proved as (for example) audio recordings [recorded using a voice recorder, etc.] and class materials provided

via PandA or other online tools.)

Depending on the course, credits may not be awarded to students who only take the classes online.

Depending on the course, students who do not attend classes in person at the university may not receive a

performance evaluation.
