Implementation of Classes during the period May 13–31

As announced in the notice “Restriction of Activities at Kyoto University (Novel Coronavirus Prevention Measures,” issued on May 10, the current Level 2- activity restrictions will be maintained at Kyoto University during the period May 13–31. In accordance with the restrictions, most classes will continue to be provided online during the specified period in order to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus.

The medical care system in Japan is currently under strain due to a nationwide resurgence of COVID-19 infections due to the emergence of new and more contagious strains of the virus. Please be assured, however, that the university intends to resume face-to-face classes as soon as possible, once the situation improves sufficiently.
