- ② Due to the large number of applicants within in the university, it is difficult to pass the screening process and be recommended.




Faculties/graduate schools with **scholarship allocations*** select the candidates for recommendation

Recommendation of successful candidates to the scholarship provider

- *The scholarship allocations for each faculty/graduate school are determined based on its number of international students.
- © Students are recommended to the scholarship providers without a university-wide screening process.
- The scholarships for which students can apply are limited to those allocated to their faculty/graduate school of affiliation.

Note: Students are free to apply for scholarships which accept direct applications and those without limits on the number of applicants that can be recommended.
