【目的】 アメリカ人の女性パイロットでゾンタクラブの会員でもあったアメリア・イアハートの遺志を受け継ぎ、航空宇宙科学や航空宇宙工学の分野に、より多くの女性が進出するのを支援する

【対象者】 航空宇宙科学関連または航空宇宙工学関連の分野の大学院博士課程に最低1年間在籍しているか、もしくはこの申し込み時点で修士号を取得した成績優秀な女性の大学院生。ただし、2021年4月以前に卒業しないこと。博士研究員の応募は不可。国際ゾンタと国際ゾンタ財団のメンバー、職員ならびに家族は除く。また、前年アメリア・イアハート奨学生は奨学期間をさらに1年延長することはできない。

【募集人数】 全世界から 30名

【奨学金】 一人当たり 1回 US \$10,000

※2年間連続して採用されれば奨学金を受け取ることができるが、2度目の応募は新規として扱い、優先的な考慮はしない。

※他の助成金や奨学金を受け取ることは構わない。

The Fellowship

The Zonta International Amelia Earhart Fellowships were established in 1938 in honor of Amelia Earhart, famed pilot and Zonta club member. The Amelia Earhart Fellowships are awarded annually to women pursuing a Ph.D./doctoral degree conducting research applied to aerospace engineering or space sciences. The Fellowship of **US\$10,000** may be used at any university or college offering accredited post-graduate courses and degrees.

Who is Eligible?

Women of any nationality pursuing a Ph.D./doctoral degree who demonstrate a superior academic record conducting research applied to aerospace engineering or space sciences are eligible. It is imperative that students be registered in a full-time Ph.D./doctoral program and have completed at least one year of that program or have received a master's degree in an aerospace-applied field at the time the application is submitted. Applicants must not graduate from their Ph.D. or doctoral program before April 2021. Please note that post-doctoral research programs are not eligible for the Fellowship. Classified members (club members and individuals with direct membership with Zonta International) and employees of Zonta International and Zonta International Foundation, and their family members (ancestors, descendants, adoptees, siblings, nieces or cousins, and those of their spouse or co-habiting partner), are not eligible to apply for the Fellowship. Note that previous Amelia Earhart Fellows are not eligible to apply to renew the Fellowship for a second year.

What are the Requirements?

Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements:

- ❑ Be registered in a full-time Ph.D./doctoral program on research applied to aerospace engineering or space sciences and have completed at least one year of that program, or, have received a master's degree in an aerospace-applied field at the time the application is submitted. A verification of current enrollment must be submitted with the application. Acceptance letters are not verification of enrollment and will not be accepted.
- ❑ Demonstrate a superior academic record at a recognized university or college with accredited courses in aerospace-applied studies as verified by official transcripts and recommendations. In programs where graduate transcripts are not provided as a matter of institutional policy, please provide a statement of that policy from the registrar or other school official. (Note: please do not upload electronic transcripts, or links to electronic copies, directly from the university as the documents may have expiration dates to review. Please scan official transcripts and/or save as a PDF and upload the saved copy in color. Please ensure all transcripts are legible.)
- ❑ Provide evidence of a well-defined research program applied to aerospace engineering or space sciences in the application essay (in general scientific terms), the academic documents (references, transcripts, verification of enrollment) and the list of publications (Note: please do not attach publications; citing the references is sufficient).
- ❑ Clearly demonstrate that the Ph.D. research program is directly related to aerospace/space sciences and furnish verification of the research program through at least one of the reference letters required with the application. The thesis supervisor or advisor and a university professor must each be one of the referees.
- ❑ Applicant must be registered in a full-time Ph.D./doctoral program by 15 November 2019 and must not graduate before April 2021.

- ❑ Biographical information
- ❑ Plans for intended study
- ❑ List and must include official detailed transcripts of grades or equivalent records from all universities, colleges, or institutions attended, including undergraduate institutions and degrees received. In programs where graduate transcripts are not provided as a matter of institutional policy, please provide a statement of that policy from the registrar or other school official. (Note: please do not upload electronic transcripts, or links to electronic copies, directly from the university as the documents may have expiration dates to review. Please scan official transcripts and/or save as a PDF and upload the saved copy in color. Please ensure all transcripts are legible.)
- ❑ List and must include translated transcripts in English of all grades from all universities, colleges or institutions attended.
- ❑ List scholarships, fellowships and honors received, if any
- ❑ List previous publications, if any (must fit in the space provided; please do not attach publications)
- ❑ Employment history, if any
- ❑ Essay on academic program and professional goals - applicant should describe, in general scientific terms, a well-defined research program (thesis) and professional goals in 500 words or less. Preference will be given to those candidates who can demonstrate a well-defined research program. Clearly demonstrate how the Ph.D./doctoral research program is directly related to aerospace engineering/space sciences.
- ❑ Three recommendations from university professors (or supervisors) who can assess your ability to succeed in the Ph.D./doctoral program. At least one of the referees must be able to describe the quality of the research program and the direct application of the research to aerospace engineering and space science. The thesis supervisor or advisor and a university professor must each be one of the referees
- ❑ Zonta International verification of current enrollment form or official statement from the university/college registrar
- ❑ All non-English documents must be translated into English to be considered
- ❑ Information other than official transcripts and recommendations must be limited to the space provided; attachments, articles, pamphlets, books, curriculum vitae or other publications are not requested and will not be considered

Process?

The Zonta International Amelia Earhart Fellowship Committee reviews the applications and recommends recipients to the Zonta International Board. All applicants are evaluated on the criteria stated in the requirements section of the application. All details of the evaluations are kept confidential; evaluations are not disclosed to applicants. All applicants will be notified of their status by the end of April 2020.

How may I use the Fellowship Funds?

The Fellowship may be used for tuition, books and fees, or living expenses (room, board or travel).

1. The payment of US\$10,000 is planned for September-October subject to any US sanctions regulation.
2. For domestic and foreign recipients studying in the United States, Fellowship funds used for tuition, books, fees, supplies or required equipment for the program of study are not considered taxable income. Withholding taxes may be required on funds used for living expenses or other non-qualified expenses, e.g. room, board or travel to conferences.
3. Recipients are not permitted to defer the Fellowship.
4. Fellows may accept additional grants and scholarships from other sources.

Deadline

The 2020 Amelia Earhart Fellowship application must be submitted by **15 November 2019** to be considered.
