program in terms of application for tuition exemption in the first

semester of the Academic Year 2023-2024

-Student to be grated (who applied) for the academic year 2023-2024

As stated in the letter of announcement "To applicants (new) of the Support for Pioneering Research Initiated by the Next Generation presented by the Division of Graduate Studies, Kyoto University and Kyoto University Science and Technology Innovation Creation Fellowship (Notification)" issued on March 14, 2023 by the Chair of the SPRING program, it was decided at the conference that all doctoral students who are selected for SPRING program and Fellowship program will be awarded a full exemption from tuition fees.

Students to be granted (who applied) must complete Step 1 and 2 for the first semester within the application period.

At the time of step 2 documents submission, submit <u>only the application form with your signature</u> by the designated deadline.

In the event that those who wish to apply for Kyoto University's own exemptions are not selected for the program, they will be required to submit documents including residence card and Form 8 "Privately-financed International Student record". Please be prepared to collect all the required documents to submit to the Student Affair Division. (Contact details provided below)

Students admitted to the program are given a full tuition waiver and do not need to apply again for the second semester.

However, in case of revocation (disqualification, withdrawal etc.) students will become ineligible for the tuition exemption for the fall semester.

Whether the same program will be continued next academic year is yet to be determined.
