Policies on JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists in application for tuition exemption etc for the second semester AY 2025-2026

ODoctoral students holding the status of a JSPS Research Fellow in AY 2025-2026 (Excluding successful candidates under AY2026-2027 adoption)

As of AY2024, all awardees of JSPS Doctoral Course Research Fellowship are to be granted a full tuition exemption under "Rules to establish special provisions on tuition exemption in support programs for doctoral students with excellent academic performance at Kyoto University".

No further action is required regarding this measure.

However, in the event of termination of the fellowship (loss of eligibility, withdrawal, etc.), tuition fees from the month of disqualification will not be exempt. Those without application for the university's independent tuition exemption (tuition exemption because of economic conditions) must pay the tuition using a transfer request form at the time of disqualification.

XStudents to withdraw from JSPS Research Fellowship and lose its status during the second semester of AY2025-2026

If you withdraw from the fellowship, you will be responsible for the remaining tuition fees from the month of disqualification.

Hence, please apply for the university's tuition exemption for the fall semester AY2025-2026 if you wish to be exempt from paying tuition fees after the withdrawal. In addition, please notify the Student Affairs Division (840menjo@mail2.adm.kyoto-u.ac.jp) of the withdrawal by email with your student number, name, and month of withdrawal included.

The remaining tuition from the month of termination of the fellowship will be exempt according to the application results for the university's tuition exemption.

OStudents enrolled in fall semester AY2025-2026 who wish to apply for admission fee exemption/ deferment

Full exemption provided to JSPS Research Fellows only applies to tuition fees. Therefore, students enrolled in fall semester AY2025 who wish to request exemption from admission fees and permission to defer its payment must apply for the university's admission fee exemption/ deferment.
