Implementation of Online Classes due to Increased Level of Activity Restriction to Prevent the Spread of the Novel Coronavirus

On April 22, the level of activity restriction at Kyoto University will be raised to Level 2-, as detailed in the university's "Guidelines for the Restriction of Activities to Prevent the Spread of the Novel Coronavirus."

Although face-to-face classes were held during the first semester of 2021, lecture course classes from April 22 (Thu.) to May 12 (Wed.) will be held online in order to protect the health and safety of students.

Experiments and laboratory course classes may continue to be held as face-to-face classes at the discretion of the providing department. In such cases, classes must be conducted while taking all possible measures to prevent the spread of infection.

The details of online classes will be provided through KULASIS, PandA, etc.

Information regarding the implementation of classes after May 12 will be provided around May 7 (Fri.) through KULASIS and on the university website.

The university asks for the understanding and patience of students regarding the unfortunate necessity of these measures. Please be assured that every effort will be made to resume face-to-face classes as soon as circumstances allow.

Please continue to take appropriate virus prevention measures to ensure the health and safety of yourself and others.
